



hanging chair
On the beach chairs one can see the mussels from up close whenever it's high tide or low tide. The chairs swing up and down along the benches with the rising and dropping water level.

mussel grill
In the Gravel mussels are given naturally on the rocks. Scraped shells will be placed to reconstruct the surrounding mussel grove.

clear water swimming
Mussels filter polluted water. Creating clear water swimming pools within the grid of poles and lines. A place where people are invited to swim laps.
