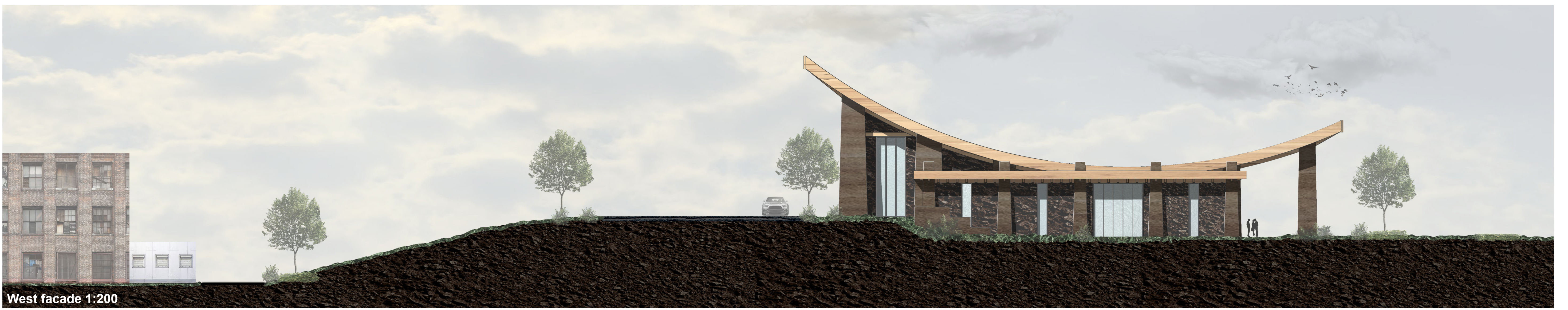

Floorplan 1:200



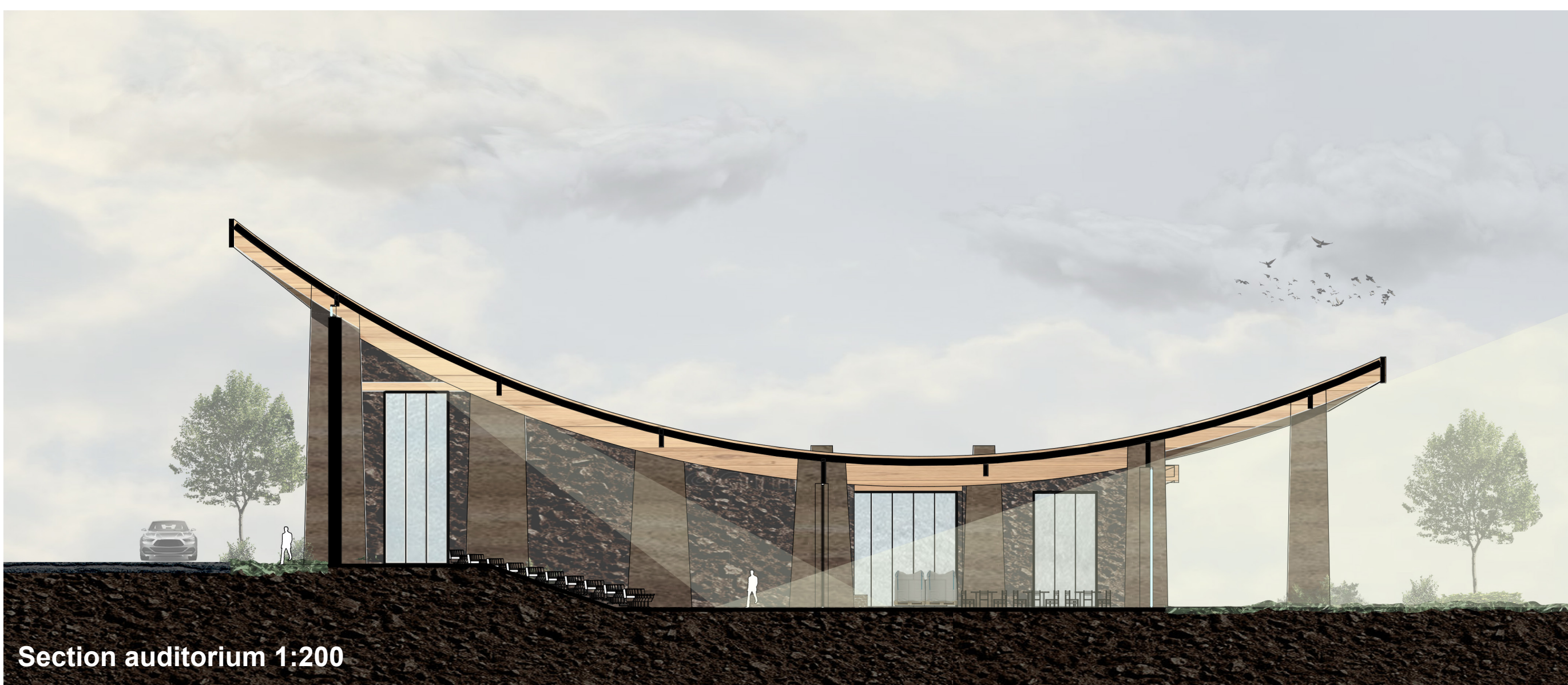
West facade 1:200



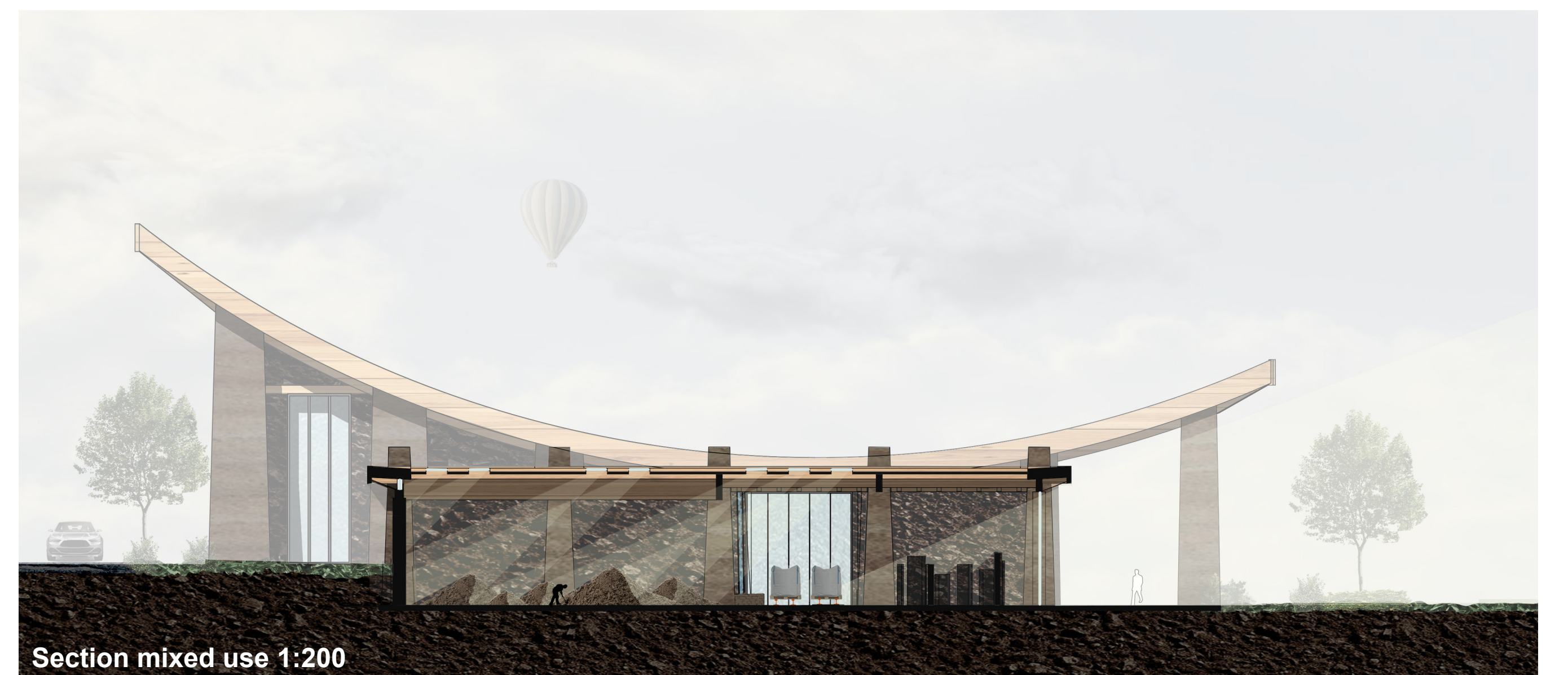
South facade 1:200

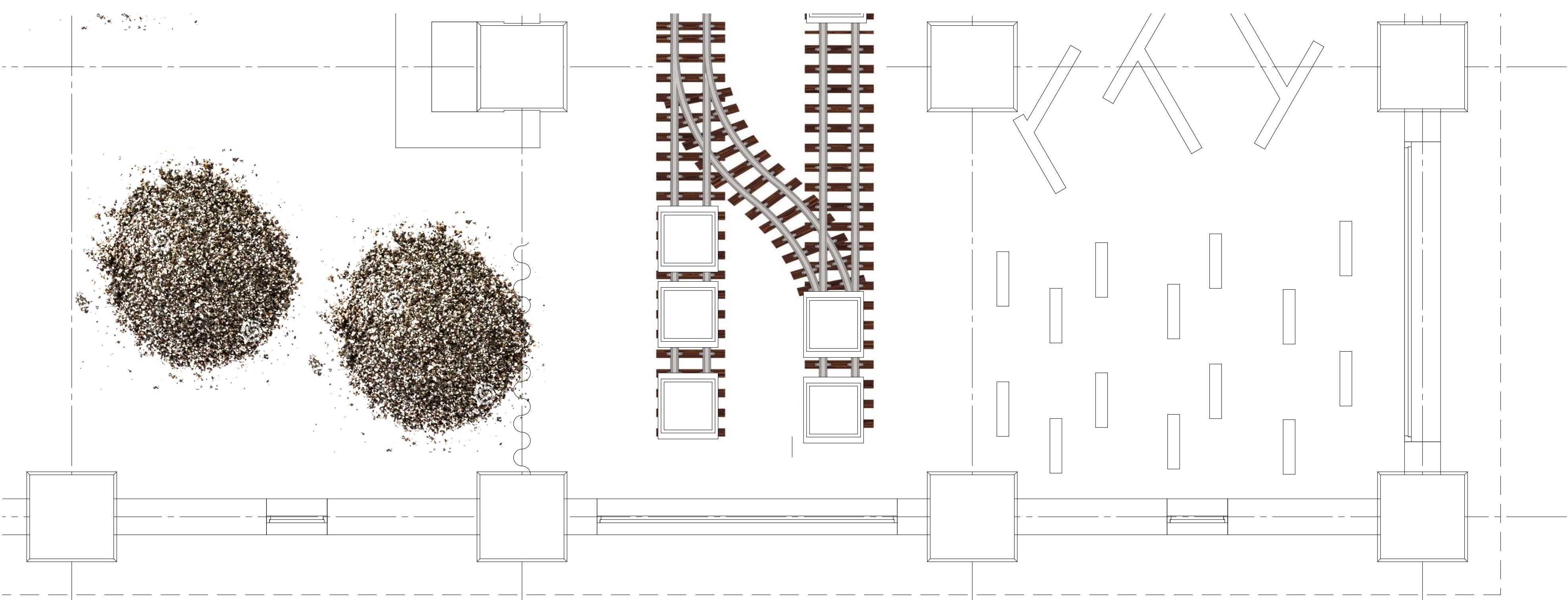
Section auditorium 1:200



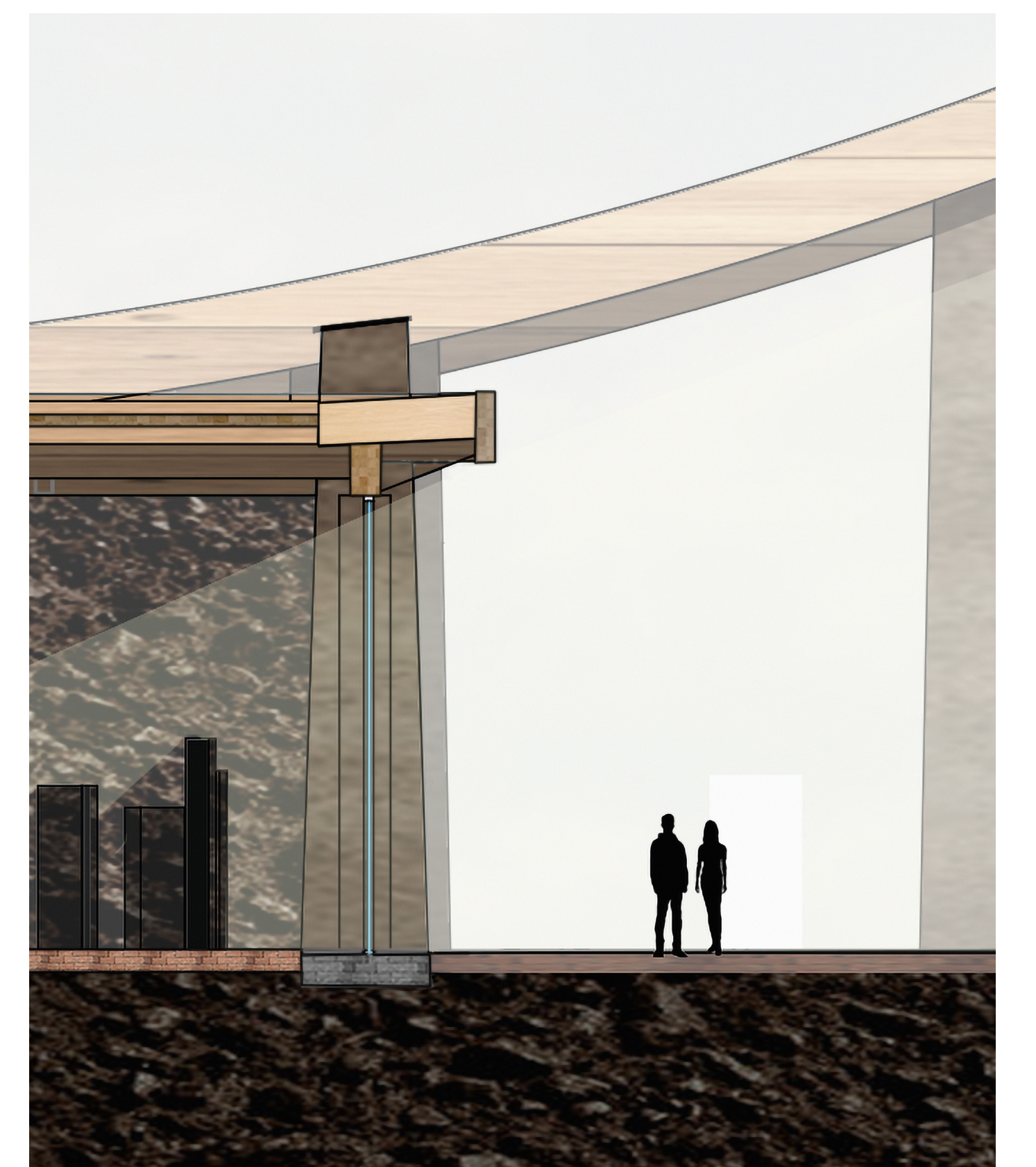
Section mixed use 1:200
