









CURRENT GREEN STRUCTURE






PUBLIC SPACE

- Maintenance by the municipality
- Owned by the municipality
- Term of the contract: everlasting
- Public function under a lease contract



COMMUNAL GARDEN

- Maintenance by the group
- Owned by the garden coöperative
- Term of the contract: 30 years, with a check on active use every 10 years



PRIVATE ALLOTMENT GARDEN COMPLEX

- Maintenance by the tenants
- Owned by the garden coöperative
 Houses are rented out by the coöperative
- Allotment rental contract: life time, with a check on active use every 10 years Rental contract for the homes: life time
- Public functions: runned by the coöperative
